

COOKIES POLICY

1. The website does not automatically collect any information, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookie files are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored on the website user's end device and are intended for the use and proper operation of the website's pages. Cookies usually contain the name of the website they come from, the storage time on the end device and a unique number.
3. The entity that places cookies on the Website User's end device and obtains access to them is the operator of the Website, Wygoda Travel Sp. z o.o. with its seat at 30-547 Kraków, Pl. Bohaterów Getta 17/14.
4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
 - a) adjusting the content of the website's pages to the user's preferences and optimizing the use of the website; in particular, these files allow for the recognition of the device of the website user and the proper display of the website, tailored to each user's individual needs;
 - b) creating statistics that help us to understand how users use the website, which allows us to improve its structure and content;
 - c) maintaining the website user's session (after logging in), thanks to which the user does not have to re-enter the login and password on each subpage of the website.
5. The website uses two basic types of cookies: session cookies and persistent cookies. Session cookies are temporary files that are stored on the user's end device until logging out, leaving the website or turning off the software (web browser). Persistent cookies are stored on the user's end device for the time specified in the cookie file parameters or until they are deleted.
6. The website uses the following types of cookies:
 - a) "necessary" cookies, enabling the use of services available on the website, including authentication cookies used for services that require authentication on the website;
 - b) cookies used to ensure security, including those used to detect fraud in the field of authentication on the website;
 - c) "performance" cookies, enabling the collection of information on the use of the website pages;
 - d) "functional" cookies, enabling "remembering" the settings selected by the user and personalization of the user interface, for example in terms of the selected language or region from which the user comes, font size, website appearance, etc.;
 - e) "advertising" cookies, enabling the delivery of advertising content more tailored to user interests.
7. In many cases, the software used for browsing websites (web browser) allows cookies to be stored on the user's end device by default. Website users can change their cookie settings at any time. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the web browser settings or to inform about their every posting on the website user's device. Detailed information on the possibilities and methods of handling cookies is available in the software (web browser) settings.
8. The operator of the website declares that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the website.
9. Cookies placed on the website user's end device may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the website operator.
